Fr. Robert Flack, SJ was born in Chicago in 1948. He attended the seminary system in the Chicago Archdiocese and was ordained a priest in 1974. After serving in several parishes in the Archdiocese, he entered the Jesuits in 1983.

As a Jesuit, he has served as a pastor on the Rosebud Reservation in South Dakota, taught sociology at Xavier University in Cincinnati,

directed retreats at the Jesuit Center for Spiritual Growth in Wernersville, Pennsylvania, and earned a PhD from the University of Washington (Seattle). He taught demography and urban studies for seven years in St. Louis University's Department of Public Policy Studies.

Fr. Flack served on the staff of the Bellarmine Jesuit Retreat House, including several months as administrator. He has also worked as an assistant in the Chicago-Detroit Province's Office of Victim Advocacy. He is currently the Director of Spiritual Life at St. Joseph College Seminary in Chicago.
