Encountering the Heart of Jesus in the Spiritual Exercises

The Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius are designed to help people develop a deeper, more personal relationship with Jesus so that "heart speaks to heart." Using those Exercises, Fr. Jim Kubicki, SJ, will help us to reflect on the infinite, unconditional love of God that invites our wholehearted response.

Included in your retreat are opportunities for mass, reconciliation, adoration, stations of the cross, the rosary, silent reflection, and a healing service.



Fr. Jim Kubicki, S.J. was born and raised in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. He entered the Jesuits in 1971, was ordained in 1983, and has worked among the Lakota Sioux people of Western South Dakota on three different occasions. From 2003 to 2017 he was the national director of the Apostleship of Prayer, the Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network, and traveled around the country giving talks, parish missions, and retreats. He is a regular contributor to the national Catholic media network, Relevant Radio, as well as Spirit Radio in Nebraska and Annunciation Radio in Ohio. He has also published several books, including "A Heart on Fire: Rediscovering Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus" and "A Year of Daily Offerings."
