

Create in Me a Clean Heart: The Spiritual Exercises for Lent

This retreat offers a time of spiritual renewal through the lens of Ignatian spirituality, drawing deeply from the themes of the Third Week of the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola. Rooted in prayer, Scripture, and the sacraments, the retreat invites participants to conversion of heart and to a more intimate companionship with Christ in His suffering. Through presentations on Presence, Grace, Sin and Freedom, the Call to Discipleship, the Way of the Cross, and A New Heart, retreatants are guided to discern how best to remain with Christ and to respond to His continual invitation to follow Him in daily life.



Fr. Fairbanks hails from Hamilton, OH and taught English and religion for many years in the US and overseas. Inspired by the life of Ignatius Loyola and Francis Xavier, he was led to enter the Society of Jesus in 1989. Ordained a priest in 2000, he has worked in Chicago in campus ministry and Province vocations. He has served as spiritual director for Jesuits, candidates, students, and adults for twelve years. Having pronounced his final vows in 2009, Fr. Fairbanks spent seven years as pastor at St. Xavier Church in Cincinnati and now serves as superior of the Jesuit community in Chicago and Chaplain at St. Ignatius College Prep.
